

UNSUPERVISED CHILDREN

In accordance with LTA advice, Royal Ascot Tennis Club recommends that children under the age of 13 are supervised by a parent or a carer whilst at the club and outside of any venue sessions, such as coaching lessons, or junior social evenings.

We advise that children under the age of 13 should not be left unsupervised even if there are other adult venue members or staff present. If the parent/carer is unable to supervise their child, then we recommend that arrangements should be made for an alternative adult or carer to provide supervision.

Parents/carers should be aware when leaving older children at the club that the courts are largely unsupervised and may also be unattended throughout the day. It is therefore advisable that parents take this into consideration and also ensure that their child is comfortable with what to do in case of emergency and are mature enough to take action if needed.
